Foreword

The Artists' Association Punjab has demonstrated for nearly three decades to be an open, all inclusive organisation. Besides successively holding 27 Annual Shows it has also held eight National Exhibitions and twelve Seminars and symposiums. The present Exhibition has on display a wide range of techniques and styles. What distinguishes the Show is its unusual diversity, where multiple ideas and forms contend with one another. A solemn portrait frowns at a merry prospect; an abstraction sneers at a miniature; calligraphy haughtily stares at a collage of images; section of a painting watchfully peers from slit of its crate; a canvas donning a 'fig leaf' brandishes an umbrella dangling from its left shoulder. Most in their respective ways are pleased with them self. Several seem wary or angry at the dreadful world.

Actually all artists are precious. Each in his/her individual way enriches collective vision of our self. But true measure of an artist is determined by time; by how the artist has gathered himself and assimilated the outside world. How he/she responds to the essential ideas and events of his time. Actually an artist cannot be more than himself - what he his self 'is'. Often work of artists who ape and imagine to be more than their own measures are often shallow. For any artist to be inspired by expression of old or modern masters is a healthy attribute. After all, whatever we paint today is the result of collective endeavour and achievements of all those who preceded us. But artists who plagiarise or mimic others or naqal without aqal have a serious problem. Devoid of truth and inner motivation art leads no where.

The Association is sometime chastened for its criteria of selection. As a policy, at the risk of reprimand, the Association encourages budding artist with visible talent. This becomes particularly important when there is a lack of interest shown by commercial art galleries in investing on emerging artists and apathy exhibited by state institutions specifically established for promotion of art and culture.

The Artists today are faced with a unique challenge. We are passing through times when our entire neighbourhood is deluged with momentous happenings. It is engulfed in blood and gunpowder smoke; by bloody violence and suicide bombings, target killings, kidnappings, sectarian assassinations and gross rampaging intolerance. Surely these tragic and dreadful events that we suffer everyday cannot be other than harbingers of better days. The old established world is dying. New ideas are sprouting. A new determination will take root. Who else can define this moment better than our own artists? We must grasp this moment; not let it slip out of our fist. No one can seize it more truly than us. No doubt these are world embracing events but we are the ones who have been directly targeted day after day, for months and for years. While most of the world reads and hears about it, we live, perceive and suffer it. This could be our moment; the moment of ushering in our Renaissance. This could be our own period of history, attributed to us by world art historian exclusively as ours. It is a challenge we cannot flee; an invitation that cannot be declined.
